And provide it to them





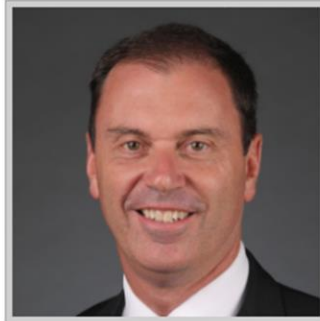

but overall really well

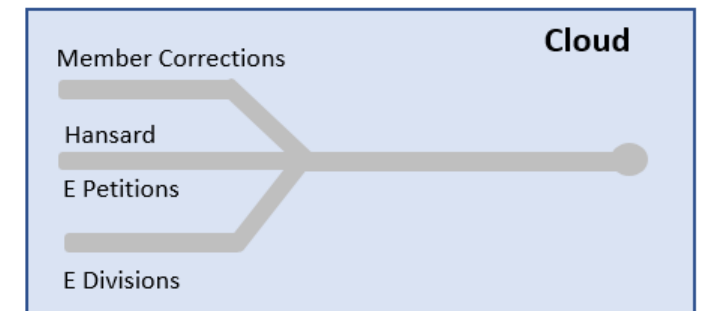
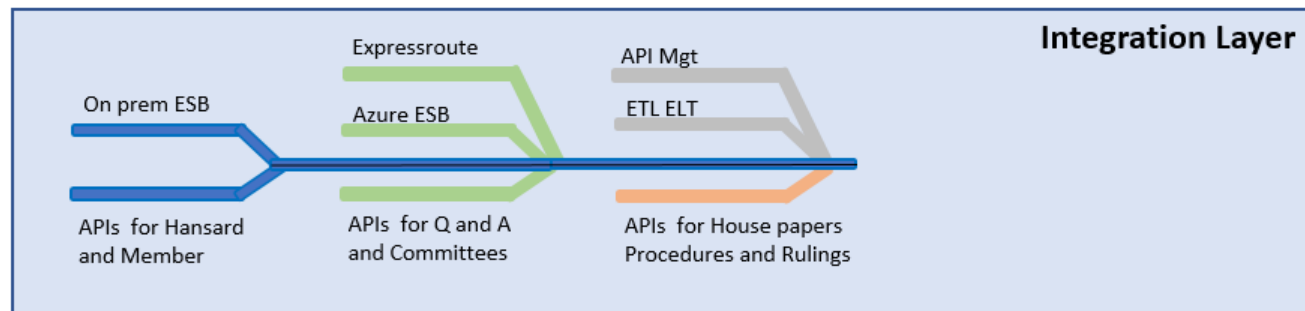
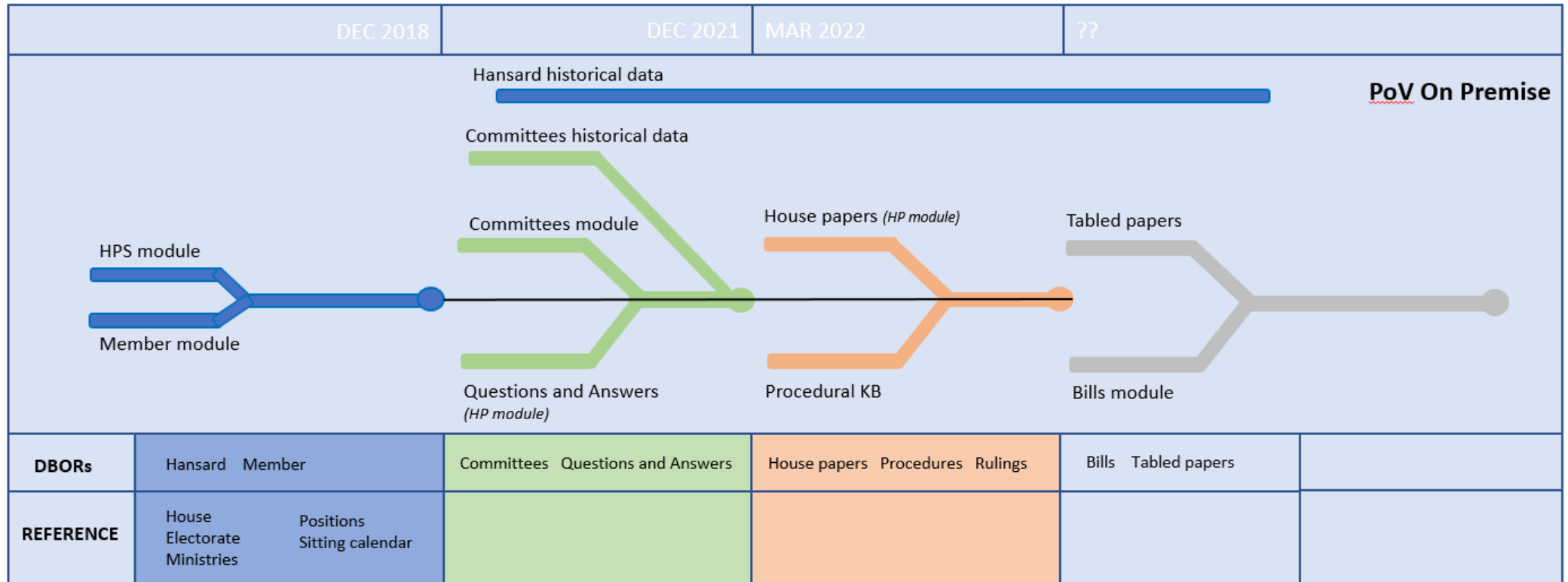


Well enough to next embark upon implementing Committees and Questions and Answers.
